Defibrillator Account

In December 2014 two residents of Irnham, Kevin and Lawrence Doran, invited residents of the parish to donate to a fund to purchase defibrillators. The response was amazing. Kevin and Lawrence secured grants and negotiated on price to enable three defibrillators to be installed, one in each of the three villages, Irnham, Bulby and Hawthorpe.

On 21st January 2015 the Parish Council agreed to take responsibility for the purchase and future running of the Defibrillators.

On 18th November 2015 the Parish Council agreed to set up a separate account for the surplus Defibrillator Funds. This account will be a Business Extra Share Account with the Norwich and Peterborough Building Society. The account will require two from three signatures, Chairman, Vice Chairman and Clerk. Funds in the Defibrillator Account are restricted as follows:

'The funds are to be used only for defibrillators, care, maintenance and insurance thereof, and any other accessories or equipment deemed necessary to the same. Should any other medical or life-saving equipment for the good of the Parish be proposed then the Parish Council should consider whether it would be an appropriate use of the fund. If the decision is in the affirmative, Messrs. Kevin and Lawrence Doran, while residents of the Parish, retain the right to veto any proposed expenditure from the account.'

The account will be audited annually with the main Parish Council account.

At the AGM of the Parish Council the Defibrillator Account will be an item on the Agenda so that the balance in the account can be made public and the use of the fund, as above, minuted.

The above statement was discussed and accepted at a meeting of the Parish Council on 13th January 2016.
