- a. **FASTER BROADBAND FOR THE PARISH** Councillors have compiled a list of all properties in the parish NOT included in Onlincolnshire Phase 3 and forwarded this to the BT Community Fibre Project Team. We await further information. Residents are very keen to progress this matter.

9. UPDATE ON HIGHWAYS ISSUES WITHIN THE PARISH

- a. Reporting of Highways issues is still a concern as the website portal is not working. Meetings have been requested to discuss concerns but no dates agreed. Clerk has written to Cllr Richard Davies, Executive Cllr for Highways and Transport but no response received. Clerk to raise these issues with Cllr Martin Hill.
- b. Cllr Ayre has reported the bad dip in the road between Bulby and Elsthorpe several times but no response to concerns.

- a. Highways have approved the scheme in principle. Cllr Vanson will return paperwork to SKDC and further the project.
