In Our Community we strive to support each other in lots of different ways. We need to make thieves aware they are not welcome. The Parish Council, PCSO, Neighbourhood Watch Coordinator and local residents have been discussing how we can be more security conscious. Please consider whether you can take any additional action to help protect your property. Below are some suggestions. The Parish Council are ordering some stickers which you are encouraged to use.

- Look out for people in the community you don't recognise. If possible ask them if you can help them and if you have concerns report these on 101. Try to note a registration number. In an emergency dial 999.



- Join the mailing list for Neighbourhood Watch information. Ask any Councillor for details.



- Tell cold callers they are not welcome.
- Install an Intruder Alarm System.



- Install outside lighting with motion sensors.



- Install CCTV and remember to advertise it.



- Check locks and bolts meet current guidelines.
- Consider marking your property.
