What have we been doing in 2017?

- Organised very successful First Aid Training on 4th February which was attended by 17 members of the Parish.
- Worked with Lincolnshire Highways to try to improve the state of the roads in the Parish. A map and details of 81 Potholes in the Parish was submitted to LCC Highways by your Parish Council. The work was acknowledged in a letter from the Local Highways Manager on 11th May but we are all frustrated by the lack of actual work being carried out. From our attendance at several meetings and ongoing discussions with Highways Staff basically there is very little money available for this work. Please see campaign poster below.

- Continued to investigate different options for faster broadband in the Parish. Scheduled dates for upgrade to fibre broadband are: Irnham Jan—Mar 2019, Bulby and Hawthorpe Jun—Sep 2019. We will continue to try to get a solution more quickly.
- Worked on projects in Bulby to place a seat by the ford and to turn the telephone kiosk into an information point.
- Supported SKDC Big Clean. A big 'Thank You' to everyone who helps keep the Parish looking tidy by collecting litter, mowing grass, clearing weeds.
- Supported LCC Campaign to get a Fairer Funding deal for Lincolnshire.
